

# JACK'S PADDOCK

Jack's Paddock is an exclusive use campground located in Kuitpo Forest 45 minutes drive from Adelaide. Set in eleven hectares of mixed eucalypt woodland Jack's Paddock is suitable for a wide range of groups including families, schools, scouts, horse riders and other events. The area is available for overnight camping or day use.

## Location

Jacks Paddock is located in Kuitpo Forest 2.5km south of the Kuitpo Forest Information Centre along Brookman Road.

## Facilities

- The hut is a two-roomed wooden structure with open doorway. It has an open fire place and room for sleeping, storage and food preparation.
- Outside there are two picnic tables, a fire pit, rainwater tanks (not suitable for drinking) and a pit toilet.
- Solar lighting inside and in front of the hut.
- Eight individual horse yards suitable for holding horses overnight.

## Bookings

- Overnight bookings are available from the 1<sup>st</sup> April – 30<sup>th</sup> November except on Total Fire Ban Days.
- Day bookings are available all year round except on Total Fire Ban days.

## Hut Fees

Hut fees are to be paid in full within 2 weeks of making your booking at the Kuitpo Forest Information Centre, or alternatively cheques can be made out to **ForestrySA** and posted to the address below.

## Terms and Conditions of Use

<u>Arrival Time</u>	Overnight: after 2.00pm Day use: after 10.30pm
<u>Vehicles</u>	Keep the entrance gate locked. Please park in the designated areas. <b>You are not permitted to drive in the forest.</b>
<u>Access Into Hut</u>	Contact the Forest Information Centre the day before your arrival to obtain the combination lock number.
<u>Disturbance</u>	The use of generators is not permitted. Please consider other forest users and keep noise levels down.
<u>Fires</u>	Fires are permitted from 1 <sup>st</sup> May to 31 <sup>st</sup> October. You may collect dead fallen timber from the adjoining pine plantation. It is an offence to cut any standing timber. <b>Solid fuel fires prohibited from 1<sup>st</sup> November to 1<sup>st</sup> May</b> <b>All fires must be fully extinguished before departure.</b>
<u>Gas Appliances</u>	The use of gas appliances is permitted from 1 <sup>st</sup> April to 30 <sup>th</sup> November.
<u>Cleaning</u>	Please leave the hut, toilet and grounds clean and tidy. <b>All rubbish to be removed from the site.</b>
<u>Departure Time</u>	Overnight users: 10.00am Day users: Before sunset

The Ranger may impose other conditions.
